# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### 1. Where is the class located?

The course is at our Paramedic campus, 5220 Pacific Concourse Drive, Los Angeles CA 90045, near LAX Airport.

#### 2. Is discounted parking available?

Yes, discounted parking is available for Friday and Monday at a discounted rate if purchased through our website (during check out) for \$3/day. Parking is free on Saturdays and Sundays. \*Please note, there are NO in and out parking privileges on the weekdays. Parking is open on the weekends. Passes for prepurchased parking will be distributed Friday morning.

# 3. Are breakfast and lunch provided?

Free continental breakfast is provided every morning. You can bring a packed lunch or purchase lunch every day. There is a cafe onsite and a cafeteria at the courthouse across the lot. A kitchen with microwaves and a refrigerator is available for your convenience.

### 4. Are there hotel accommodations available?

We have a contract with Courtyard Los Angeles LAX/Hawthorne with discounted rates. They also provide a convenient free shuttle service to and from the hotel and the PM course. For reservations, visit the registration link on our course page.

## 5. Do I have to attend all four days of the course?

Yes, if you wish to receive the course completion certificate for this PM refresher course (48 hours). If you miss any part of the course, you will still receive the CE hours for the total time you attended. For example, anyone leaving early (more than one hour), or arriving late (more than one hour), will be marked absent and will only receive CE hours and will be ineligible for the course completion certificate. Please let the coordinator know if you know you will have to miss any of class.

## 6. Is there homework?

Yes, in order to receive the full 48 hours for paramedic refresher course, the homework is awarded as 10 asynchronous CE hours.

### 7. What are the requirements for NREMT renewal?

The Paramedic National Continued Competency Program (NCCP) requires a total of 60 hours of continuing education to recertify. The model requires continuing education in three components: (1) a national component, (2) a local/state component, and (3) an individual component. This course provides the 30 hours required for the national component, and an additional 18 hours you may use for your state/local recertification. ## 8. What else do I need to bring?

Bring your NREMT license number or your county number.
